■ **"Eyes for India,"** a Rotary Club of Youngstown project, has raised more than \$40,000 for eye treatment and equipment for needy residents of the rural village of Godhra, India. The club was to hear a report from member Raxit Shah, project organizer, at its meeting today. The Rotary Club of Godhra supervised fund disbursement. Contributions included \$15,000 from Youngstown Rotary; a matching grant of \$15,000 from Rotary International; and \$5,000 from Shah and his wife, Ketki. The remaining money included personal gifts by area Rotarians and Indian groups in Youngstown and Cleveland.
